Entries Accepted until May 1, 2014

January 8, 2014, Stony Brook, NY – The 19th Annual Stony Brook Film Festival is accepting entries of new independent features, documentaries and shorts for the highly curated, popular ten-day festival, being held at Staller Center for the Arts, July 17-26, 2014. The Stony Brook Film Festival’s policy of no entry fee for film submissions continues, thanks to its sponsors, HBO, Suffolk County, Teachers Federal Credit Union, the Village Voice and WALK 97.5 Radio.

“The Stony Brook Film Festival’s mix of outstanding new foreign films, premieres of all kinds and shorts paired with features has given the Festival an outstanding reputation. Above all, we look for quality filmmaking and story telling,” notes Alan Inkles, director of Staller Center and the Stony Brook Film Festival. “We know we are succeeding because filmmakers return with their films after they’ve been here once, and audience members come back year after year.
